

# Important Local Information

It has probably not escaped your notice that a group of travellers have moved onto the piece of land opposite Braywood Hall on the junction of Oakley Green Road with Fifield Lane.

On Mon 23 Feb the retrospective application for 4 ancillary amenity buildings, 4 static and 4 travelling

caravans, and a new access was unanimously rejected by Bray Parish Council on the grounds of harm to the Green Belt, lack of provision for drainage or flooding, and the proximity of the proposed entrance to the Fifield crossroads. This application now goes to the Borough Planners.

At the Parish meeting the councillors were asked to “call in” this application to ensure that it can be discussed in ‘open forum’ where members of the public are allowed to attend and comment. If this meeting takes place we will encourage as many residents as possible to attend.
